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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cattle – Sale Condition – Must be in condition to be able to sell. Cattle must possess a minimum 5+ body condition score. However, a 6 or above body condition score is preferred. |

These pictures/videos should arrive early and will not be used for DVAuction. DVAuction videos may be submitted after cattle are clipped and quality video is taken. |

- Any member of BBU and a paid member of LSBBA is eligible to nominate cattle for this sale. If you are not a paid member of LSBBA, send \$35.00 dues payable to LSBBA to Richard Statser, PO Box 147, Canton, TX 75103.
- **Open Heifer Futurity, Bred Heifer Futurity and Bull Futurity.** Entry is optional. The entry fee for the futurity is \$100.00 per lot. Payout in each class: 1st Place 60%, 2nd Place 30%, 3rd Place 10%. ADDED MONEY of \$10,000 for Champions. Female Grand Champion - \$4,000, Reserve Champion - \$2,500, 3rd Place - \$1,200. Bull Futurity Bull Grand Champion - \$1,500, Reserve Champion Bull - \$800.
- Nomination Fee of \$50.00 per lot. (Non-Refundable). If you do not bring the lot to the sale, nomination fee is forfeited.
- Display pens are available for \$100.00, if possible, your display pen will be adjacent to your lot.
- Judging: All futurity open heifers bred heifers and bulls will be judged Friday, December 4, 2026, at 3:00 pm.
- Futurity winners will begin the sale. Once the futurity champions are sold, the following sale order is up to Sales Manager, Mike Green.
- A semen lot will be sold to support the sale.
- Dinner and Fun Auction will follow Grading on Friday night. Dinner is complimentary for members. Bring a fun auction item to help support the sale.
- Ranch Inspections are not required but are available. Mike Green is available to assist in selecting cattle for sale. Cell: 972-229-6563. Send the consignment form early to ensure scheduling a visit. Cost: \$50.00 per head for the first two head.

DV Auction Video:

- A link to the sale on DV Auction will be emailed. Sale Quality Videos to post on DV Auction may be submitted after the animal is in sale condition and clipped. Cost \$10.00. Health Papers: Must be dated within 30 days of sale and signed by a licensed Veterinarian.

- A separate health paper (certificate) issued by a licensed veterinarian is required on each lot consigned.
- Animal ID (Traceability Requirement)
- TB Free – Texas does recognize TB Free States and Brucellosis. You do not have to have a TB test unless you are from an area that requires it. If you have any questions, check with your vet, or go to www.tahc.state.tx.us. If you are out of state, check with your vet on health requirements.
- Bulls – Trich Tested and Fertility Tested and Scrotal Circumference
- Bulls – BSE (Breeding Soundness Evaluation) Test. BSE form from BBU or form issued by the Society of Theriogenology may be submitted.
- Females – All females must be palpated and results noted on health papers.
- Health papers must accompany all cattle upon delivery at sale site.

Bulls (18 – 36 months old) Limit 15 head.

- Bulls are required to have EPD's – Weaning Weight and Yearling Weight
- Performance scan data is required. Performance Scan Data criteria must be on file at BBU.
- DNA recorded at BBU is strongly recommended. Market your bull to the fullest with DNA and your buyer will have confidence in their new herd bull.
- Acceptance/Inspection of bull by Mike Green. Please contact Mike for onsite inspection at 979-229-6563. Call early as 15 head will be accepted.

3-N-1's and Pairs (Age Limit 72 mos. 6 yrs.)

- Female with calf at side age over 6 months must be palpated safe in calf and noted on health papers.

Bred Cows (Age Limit 72 mos., 6 yrs.)

- Bred Cows must have prior progeny listed with BBU or they are not eligible. (“P” or “C” BBU number on prior calves will be checked.)
- Bred Cow must be palpated safe in calf by a licensed vet, and this information must appear in health papers.

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Bred Heifers and Exposed Heifers (Age Limit 15 to 32 months.)

- Bred Heifer must be palpated safe in calf by a licensed vet, and this information must appear in health papers. Exposed heifers will sell in the Bred Heifer category.
- EPD's and Performance Scan Data (scanned at ages 320 to 450 days) – Bred Heifers are required to have Performance Scan Data criteria recorded at BBU.
- DNA recorded at BBU is strongly recommended. Market your heifer to the fullest with DNA and your buyer will have confidence in their new purchase.

Open Heifers (Age limit up to 22 months of age)

- Open heifers should be palpated open by a licensed vet, and this information must appear in health papers.
- EPD's and Performance Scan Data (ages 320 to 450 days) – Open Heifers 14 months or older on sale day will be required to have Performance Scan Data criteria recorded at BBU.
- DNA recorded at BBU is strongly recommended. Market your heifer to the fullest with DNA and your buyer will have confidence in their new purchase.

Lone Star Board of Directors reserve the right to make judgement calls on any variations of the above requirements.
